

### Congratulations

You are now the owner of a Zelco Long Reach Flexible Flashlight™. This unique product has "state of the art" optics. The Krypton lamp produces a high intensity light. The unique focusing ability allows changing from a flood to a spot beam. O ring in lamp head provides for maximum water resistance. The flexible tube can extend 9 inches and may be bent in any shape. The tube winds around the case for compact storage. A red lens and spare lamp are stored in the case.

Like all Zelco products the Long Reach Flexible Flashlight™ is made of the finest materials available and to the highest standards of technological craftsmanship. Please read instructions before using it.

### Inserting Batteries

Lift battery cover at edge (A) (Fig. 1) and pull off (B). Insert 2 fresh Alkaline "AAA" batteries, making sure the (+) end of battery faces in the direction shown in (Fig. 2) or as appears inside the case. Replace cover. Use the sliding switch to operate the light. (Fig. 2).

### Red Lens

Drivers, aircraft pilots, boaters and others use red light for quick vision adjustments in the dark. The red lens is stored inside the flashlight case. Open battery cover as shown in (Fig. 1). Remove red lens (Fig. 2) and slip over lamp head top (Fig. 3). Push it all the way on.

### Focusing Flood to Spot Beam

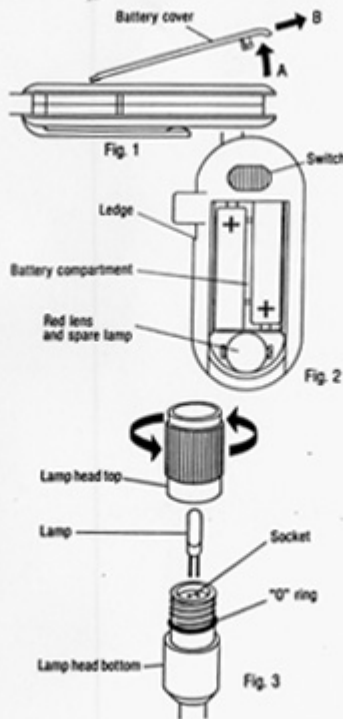
You can vary your lighted area, depending upon your needs. Slowly rotate the lamp head top (Fig. 3) to gradually change from floodlight to a spot beam or vice versa.

### To Wrap Tube Around Case

The flexible tube can be wrapped around case in the groove along the side. Wrap tightly so that the lamp head bottom (Fig. 3) rests on ledge (Fig. 2) in groove. It now can be operated as a compact flashlight.

### Pocket Clip

Your Long Reach Flexible Flashlight™ can be clipped onto your pocket. To provide light for reading in dimly lit areas, merely extend the lamp head and you have a hands-free book light.



### Replacing Lamp

Your spare lamp is stored in the case under the red lens (Fig. 2). Remove red lens and pull out lamp. Unscrew lamp head top (Fig. 3). Pull the old lamp straight out from the socket in the lamp head bottom. Insert new spare lamp by firmly pushing the 2 prongs straight into the 2 holes so that the base of the lamp touches the socket. Replacement lamps are available in 2-lamp packs. If not stocked by your dealer, send us \$7.00 to cover the cost of the lamps, postage and handling. Please print your name and address and request replacement part No. 90013.
